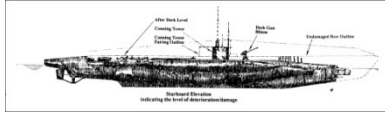

Wreck Diving German Submarine U-85



Join Sea Ventures, Sep 25 & 26, to dive the only Type VII-B U-boat to be found in U.S. Coastal waters

Just off the coast of North Carolina lies the remains of the German U-boat *U-85*. For more than 66 years, *U-85* has rested off our Nation's coast, slowly revealing her story and offering us glimpses into a past that many Americans are unaware even existed. On April 13, 1942, *U-85* was sitting in shallow water only a few miles from the North Carolina coast, just off the Bodie Island lighthouse when she was detected by the USS Roper. *U-85* became the first enemy submarine sunk by a US Naval warship in the Second World War – and she remains to this day, an exciting dive destination.

This will be a recreational dive to a maximum depth of 102' feet. This dive is recommended for recreational divers with an advanced open-water or equivalent certification and wreck-diving experience. We will dive both Saturday and Sunday – with the plan to dive the *U-85* twice on one of those days; weather permitting. Cost of dive will be \$130/day + \$15/pps fuel charge. Divers will be expected to dive both Saturday and Sunday. Divers will be responsible for own accommodations – which can be found at <http://www.obxdive.com/>. You can dive it on regular air, but you will have more bottom time if you dive it on NITROX. The local dive shop pumps 32% NITROX and will custom mix NITROX as requested. Get your Nitrox Training at Sea Ventures.

Required Equipment: Two Tanks (Filled), Regulator w/alternate air source, Buoyancy Compensator, Weights and Weight Belt, Wetsuit – (at least 6MM), Air Gauge, Depth Gauge, Bottom Timer or Computer, Dive Tables, Knife, Certification Card(s), Logbook, Wreck Reel, Lift Bag, Underwater light, Surface Signaling device.

Recommended Equipment: Alternate Air Source, Gloves, Hood, Sea Sick Medicine, Camera, Save-A-Dive kit, Dry Bag, Slate, Lunch/drinks, Sunglasses, Sunscreen, Hat, Warm Clothes, Towel, Redundant Light, Dive Insurance.

You will be responsible for all of your own transportation to Nags Head, NC, as well as to the dock each morning.
